At the Montgomery County Humane Society, "Golden Oldies" are cats age 7 or older. These fabulous felines still have a long life ahead of them, but are nevertheless often overlooked at the shelter. Reduced Adoption Fees:

When adopting a "Golden Oldie," seniors pay reduced adoption fees.*

Veterinary Financial Assistance:

Seniors are also eligible to apply for financial assistance after adopting their "Golden Oldie" if the cat requires veterinary care for chronic health conditions such as diabetes, hyperthyroidism, cardiac disease, and chronic kidney failure (other conditions may be approved upon request). Upon approval, the patron will be partially reimbursed based on income.**

* The patron will be required to pay for the cost of micro-chipping and licensing. Vaccinations or medical treatments administered at the shelter will be waived.

** The program will not reimburse patrons electing to use chemotherapy and/or radiation treatment. The patron must use a veterinarian who participates in MCHS programs; the list of these veterinarians is available on request.
